What will my child do each day?



We understand that every child has different interests which is reflected in our dynamic range of over 350 activities.

Your child will take part in up to nine structured activities each day, four each from both the DISCOVERY & ENDEAVOUR ZONES, an organised free play session after lunch and plenty of breaks throughout the day. If you require childcare beyond the standard 10.00am to 4.00pm day, our EXTENSION ZONE enables you to drop off from 8.15am and pick up as late as 6.00pm.

How will my child be looked after?



For our youngest age group, the emphasis is on fun and play in a caring and safe environment.

We use small activity areas, simplified rules and adapted equipment and encourage all our Krazy K's to develop at their own pace. All Krazy K's are allocated a Key Person to ensure they settle in and get the most out of their time with us.



Each age group has its own identity and is allocated coaches who best suit their needs. Suitably qualified staff, including Paediatric First Aiders, are present at the club at all times.

All activities are delivered in an age appropriate manner with the emphasis on fun for our youngest children and a different focus on development as the children get a little older.

Please note grouping on the day may be subject to change due to regulatory staff to child ratio requirements.



Our middle age group follow a programme of activity that helps them to develop their growing sense of interest in everything around them. Action, excitement and discovery await every Kool K.









Exclusive to our eldest attendees!

For our King K's, all the fun and excitement of the Kool K's is retained, but within an environment that encourages independence and individuality.

The King K day includes a child-led, multi-choice programme in the morning and the afternoons are spent taking part in 'King Club' and 'Extreme Team'. Both afternoon sessions happen well away from the rest of the activity groups, ensuring our King K's really do feel like they are in their own 'club environment'.



King Club Zone

Our King K's are given the chance both to chill out with friends and take part in a selection of cool games and activities, including Table Football, Den Building, Card Games, Art Tables, Board Games, Rubix Cubes, Jewellery Making and much more!

Xtreme Team

The last hour of the day is devoted to a 'fast and furious' activity which introduces our King K's to an appropriate level of risk and challenge. Children can choose from a host of activities including House of Fun, Elves, Wizards & Giants, Capture the Flag, Escape Rooms and Everybody's It.
